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US California Added Six Chemicals to Prop 65 List



On September13, 2019, California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) has added the following six chemicals to the Proposition 65 list as carcinogens:

- 2-Amino-4-Chlorophenol
- 2-Chloronitrobenzene
- 1.4-Dichloro-2-Nitrobenzene
- 2,4-Dichloro-1-Nitrobenzene
- N,N-Dimethylacetamide
- Para-Nitroanisole

All six chemicals above have been listed by the "Labor Code mechanism". If the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC)identifies a certain chemical as causing cancer or reproductive harm, OEHHA can add it to the Prop 65 list.

This listing updates became effective on September 13, 2019. Warnings are required for significant exposures to listed chemicals starting 12 months after OEHHA adds the chemicals to the list, September 13, 2020.
